SUBJECT: UNDERGROUND SINGLE PHASE SERVICE TO SUBDIVISIONS

POLICY:

The cooperative will make single phase underground electric service available to subdivisions in its service in accordance with its bylaws and under the following terms and conditions:

A. GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. The subdivision shall have four or more contiguous lots that have been platted, approved, recorded and comply with all applicable laws and regulations.
2. The subdivision developer shall stake and clearly mark all lot corners within the stated subdivision prior to the installation of any electric facilities.
3. The recorded subdivision plat shall show a utility easement adjacent to all streets and roads for the placement of all electric lines, transformers and pedestals. No electric facilities will be placed on back lot lines that are not accessible by a street or an alley. The subdivision developer shall perform all necessary clearing of the utility easement.
4. The subdivision developer shall deliver a letter to the cooperative stating that all easements and right of ways are at their final grade.

B. CONSTRUCTION DEPOSIT

The cooperative will require a non-refundable aid-in-construction payment equal to 75% of the actual construction cost for each lot to which electrical service is provided.
