

**EGYPTIAN ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE ASSOCIATION
POLICY BULLETIN NO. 506**

SUBJECT: THREE-PHASE SERVICE

POLICY:

The cooperative will make three-phase service available in its service area in accordance with its by-laws and under the following terms and conditions:

A. APPLICABILITY

Service under this policy will be provided where the member installs a minimum of

1. A 15-horsepower or larger three-phase motor, or
2. A 10-horsepower with an aggregate of 20-horsepower or more of three-phase motors.

B. GENERAL CONDITIONS

The member will furnish:

1. A \$50.00 non-refundable new service fee
2. A security deposit (if required) (See Policy104)
3. All necessary easements
4. Cleared right-of-ways

C. OVERHEAD SERVICE

The member will furnish:

1. A meter loop constructed in accordance with the cooperative's specifications.
2. A non - refundable aid-in-construction payment equal to 100% of the actual construction cost for each circuit foot of primary line or secondary line in excess of 250 feet.

D. UNDERGROUND SERVICE

1. The member will furnish:

- a. A non-refundable aid-in-construction contribution equal to 100% of the actual construction cost for each circuit foot of primary line or secondary line in excess of 100 feet.

*The cooperative will make no primary line extensions of less than 100 circuit feet.

2. The member will pay the total cost of labor and materials to convert an overhead service to underground.

E. MINIMUM MONTHLY BILL

The minimum charge of \$30.00 shall include required transformer capacity to a maximum of 30 KVA. The monthly minimum charge shall be increased by \$1.00 per KVA for required transformer capacity exceeding 30 KVA.

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F. CONSTRUCTION DEPOSIT

The cooperative reserves the right to require an applicant to deposit an amount equal to 50% of the estimated construction costs, prior to construction, to assure security of the cooperative's investment. This deposit is refundable at the time the applicant's facilities start to use three-phase power.

G. ADDITIONAL CHARGES OR DEPOSITS

Because three-phase loads can differ substantially both in size and electrical service requirements, investment cost on the part of the cooperative can vary considerably. The charges and deposits stated in this policy shall be considered minimums and they will be increased on an individual basis as determined by the cooperative's engineering or management personnel.
