**SUBJECT:   REMOVAL OF IDLE SERVICES**

**POLICY:**

This policy provides a consistent method for the removal of idle services. This is to save maintenance costs, prevent vandalism and energy diversion.

1.   Egyptian Electric Cooperative must comply with the National Electric Safety Code, which states that we must maintain all lines, energized or not, to the specifications set forth by this code.
2.   As a general practice, a service that has not been energized for a period of one year may be scheduled for removal. The Cooperative has the right to remove idle services with or without permission of the member. Efforts shall be made to contact the member prior to removal.
3.   If the member wishes to leave the service in place, they will be subject to the monthly facility charge.

**RESPONSIBILITY**

The Engineering Manager and/or the Executive Vice-President/General Manager shall be responsible for seeing that this policy is followed.
